Word counts for your report are given below. Required word count depends on the number of credits for which you are registered in the current semester. Total word counts should not include words on this form.

- 1 credit: 750 -1000 words
- 2 credits: 1300 – 1600 words

- 4 credits: 1800 – 2100 words

Your project summary should be WRITTEN in PARAGRAPH form and include the components listed below. You may enter your report into the into the text field provided on the form. Alternatively, you may submit your final report as a Word or PDF attachment (include your name and project title)

BACKGROUND: Provide an overview of the topic you investigated. What was known about your topic before your project started and why was the topic important to study?

HYPOTHESIS TESTED: Provide a concise statement of the experimental hypothesis that your experiment was designed to test.

METHODS: Provide a brief overview of the methods you performed as part of your research.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS, RESULTS AND CONCLUSIONS: Provide a summary in paragraph form of your accomplishments or results, and your interpretation of your findings. Did your results support your hypotheses or predictions? Why or why not? What is the significance of your results? If your project is unfinished and ongoing, explain its current status and describe what accomplishments and progress you made this semester in developing or refining your methods or design.
